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Cwrs Cymraeg Wlpan LEFEL MYNEDIAD

Mae'r cwrs Wlpan yn rhoi ffocws ar ddatblygu sgiliau siarad a gwrando, er y bydd peth darllen ac ysgrifennu. Mi fydd dysgwyr yn gyfarwydd â holl batrymau sylfaenol Cymraeg llafar ac mi ddylen nhw fedru cynnal sgysiau pob dydd sylfaenol erbyn diwedd y cwrs.

Dan ni'n cynnig y cwrs mewn amrywiaeth o fformatau:

a) **Superwlpan** dwys, 23 awr/pum diwrnod yr wythnos ym Mangor. Dach chi'n medru cwblhau'r ffeil Wlpan gyfan erbyn y Nadolig ac yn medru symud ymlaen yn syth i'r cwrs Superpellach ym mis Ionawr.

b) **Wlpan carlam**, 3 – 4 awr yr wythnos. Dach chi'n medru cwblhau'r ffeil Wlpan cyfan mewn dwy flynedd. Mae'r cwrs carlam ar gael mewn dau fformat:

i) 3 – 4 awr yr wythnos yn yr ystafell ddosbarth

ii) **"Hanner a Hanner"** = dysgu mewn dosbarth am 2.5 awr yr wythnos

+ gwneud gwaith ar-lein yn eu hamser eu hunain.

Mi fydd yr elfen ar-lein yn cynnwys gwersi fideo, adnoddau testun a sain rhyngweithiol ac apiau symudol.

Wlpan Welsh Courses ENTRY LEVEL

The Wlpan is a well-established conversational course for complete beginners. The focus will be on developing speaking and listening skills, although there will be some reading and writing to reinforce the learning. Participants will be familiar with all the basic patterns of spoken Welsh and should be able to hold basic everyday conversations by the end of the course.

We offer the course on a variety of formats:

a) **Intensive Superwlpan**, 23 hours/five days a week at Bangor. Those attending this course will complete the full Wlpan file by Christmas and can then move straight on to the Superpellach course in January.

b) **Fast-track Wlpan**, 3 – 4 hours per week. The extended hours will mean that learners will build up a good learning momentum and should complete the full Wlpan course in two years. The fast-track is available in two formats:

i) 3 – 4 hours per week of purely class-based learning

ii) **"Half and Half"** - Learners usually attend classes for 2.5 hours a week

+ work on-line in their own time.

The on-line element will include video lessons, interactive text and audio resources and mobile apps.
